

Newspaper-Tape Sculptures

Today you'll have the chance to use your imagination and make your very own figurative or abstract sculpture!



Included in your Kit:

- craft sticks
- one roll of tape
- newspaper

What You'll Need:

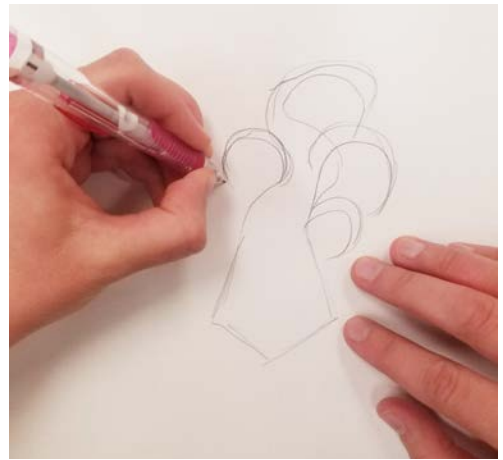
- paints
- paintbrushes



Step 1: Design Your Sculpture

Think of what type of sculpture you would like to make and sketch it on a piece of paper.

It could be an animal, a person, an object, or something completely out of your own imagination!



Step 2: Make a Frame

Use your craft sticks and tape to make a frame that you can build the rest of your sculpture around.



Step 3: Add Newspaper

Now, you can crunch, roll up, or twist newspaper around your frame to add interesting shapes and designs to your sculpture. Secure each section of newspaper with tape.



Step 4: Cover in Tape

Once your sculpture looks the way you wanted it to, make sure it is entirely covered in tape. This makes it sturdier and easier to paint.



Step 5: Paint

The last step is to paint your masterpiece. Add as many colors and details as you would like!
